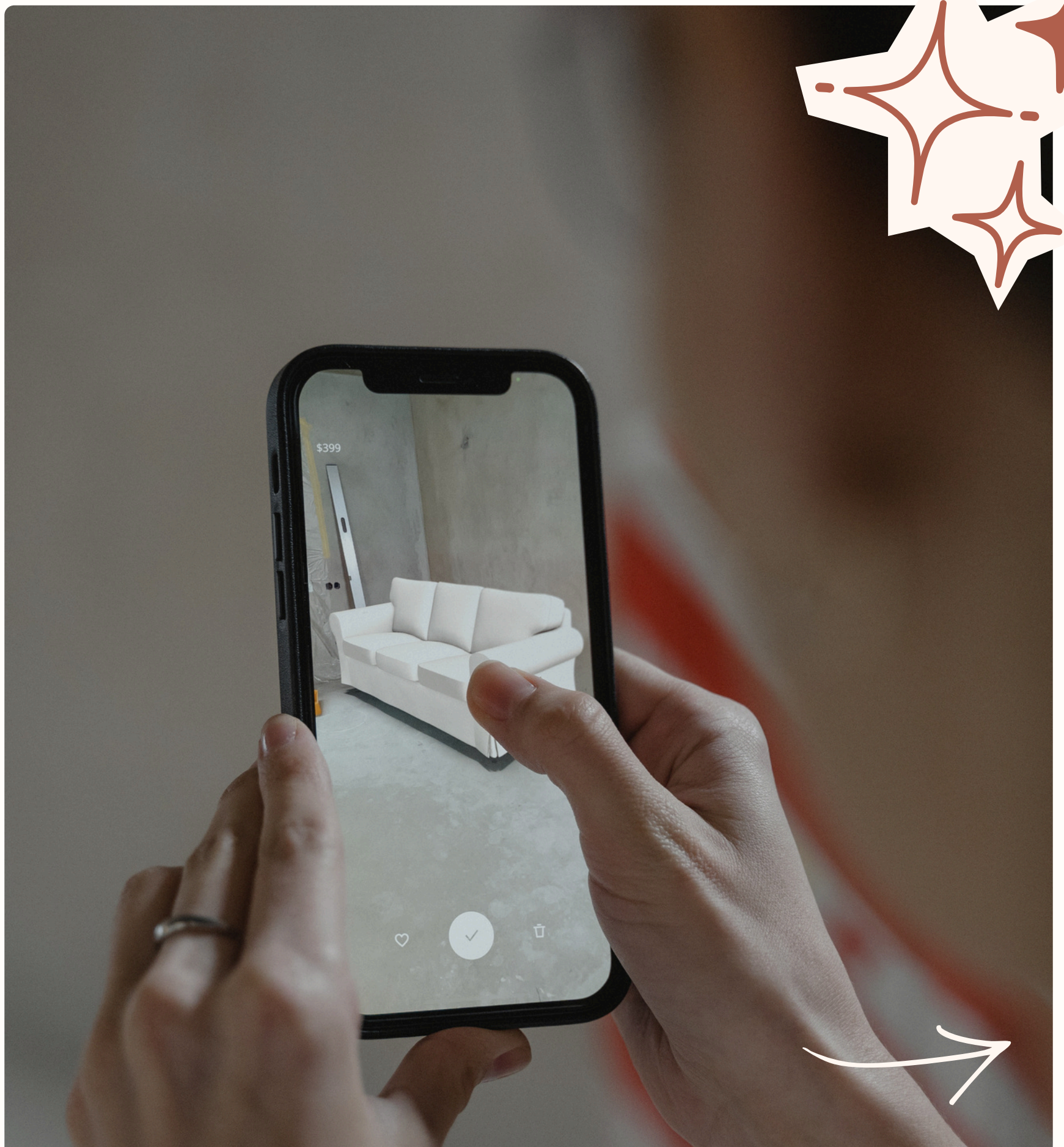

- Perplexity – for quick product research and clarification before validating in DesignSpec

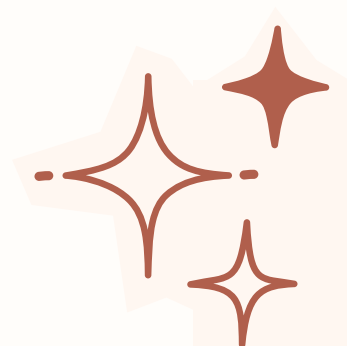
DesignSpec already centralizes product specifications, pricing, and vendor data. AI enhances this process by acting as an intelligent assistant before, during, and after specification.

## 2. Enhancing Project Management with AI

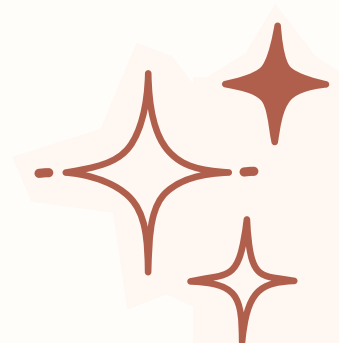
Design Manager is purpose-built for the financial and operational backbone of design projects. When combined with project management tools, AI can help connect these systems and reduce effort.

*This avoids double entry while keeping teams aligned.*

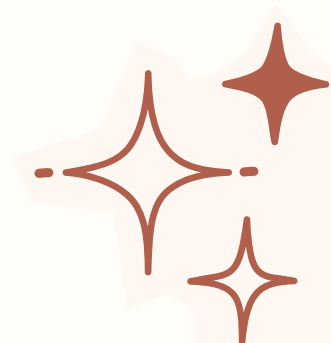
## 3. Better Client Communication with AI

To build internal systems and documentation, teams frequently rely on:

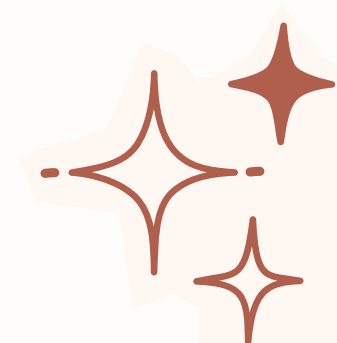
- **Notion AI** – SOPs, onboarding guides, and internal wikis

- **RoomGPT** – instant visual concepts based on uploaded room photos

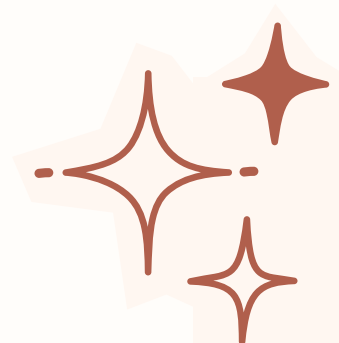
*These tools are best suited for inspiration, early ideation, & client-facing visuals, not final construction documents.*
